## Improving education in Korogocho

- □ St John's Library Extension +200m<sup>2</sup>
- Capacity doubled: more books, more beneficiaries
- Creating ICT centre and providing ICT training
- Energy-efficient LED lighting + an electricity back-up system with solar-powered batteries
- 3000 new textbooks were purchased (1000 more to be bought in 2017)
- Renovating Emmaus facility




